An outline of today's sermon:

"PURE GRACE FOR YOU!"

Text: Romans 5:6-8 "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly... But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

INTRODUCTION – In building a house, the foundation is the most important thing: it must be solid, straight and level. It is no different in the business of building lives. One needs a firm foundation to build upon, and from which to take direction. The grace of God in our lives is that foundation. History and time prove that those who trusted in the grace of God were never disappointed, frustrated or defeated!

- 7 The order: Christ first died for us then we believed.

CONCLUSION – During the Sundays in Lent the weekly themes are rich in grace. They all point to a loving God who is always ready to come to the rescue of the sinners. This is just the ticket we need when we confront ourselves with God's law and realize our sinfulness. In the dark despair caused by our contrition and repentance, we find the light of the Father's love and forgiveness. He will never leave us or forsake us! Amen.

THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT

Jesus Overcomes the Strong Man

Jeremiah was charged with speaking evil when he spoke the Word of the Lord (Jer. 26:1–15). So also, Jesus is accused of doing evil when in fact He is doing good. He casts out a demon from a mute man so that he is able to speak (Luke 11:14–28). But some said Jesus did this by the power of Beelzebub, Satan. Like Pharaoh of old, their hearts were hard (Ex. 8:16–24). They did not recognize the finger of God, the power of the Holy Spirit at work in and through Jesus. Jesus is the Stronger Man who overcomes the strong man. He takes the devil's armor of sin and death and destroys it from the inside out by the holy cross. He exorcizes and frees us by water and the Word. We were once darkness, but now we are light in Christ the Lord (Eph. 5:1–9). As children of light, our tongues are loosed to give thanks to Him who saved us.
