"JESUS EMPOWERS THE CHURCH"

Text: John 20:22-23 "And with that he breathed on them and said,' Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone his sin, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

INTRODUCTION – The news of Jesus' resurrection that Sunday morning just became a lot better on that Sunday evening! Just think: the disciples had not actually seen Jesus. There were sketchy reports that he had appeared to some women, but they were not talking. They seem bewildered and overwhelmed. His tomb was empty, Peter and John had seen it. The disciples saw what they had done to Jesus. Fearing for their lives, they hid in a room and locked the doors.

- 1 They locked the doors for a reason!
- 2 An unexpected visitor: Jesus appears to them.
- 3 He IS risen! They can see that! Now, what?
- 4 They had seen what they had done to him.
- 5 Will he fight back? Wage war? Destroy them with one little word?
- 6 They all had abandoned him; they all felt ashamed.
- 7 What will he do? Fire them? No. Employ them!
- 8 Give them His peace and send them to save us in the 21st century!

CONCLUSION – Jesus' first appearance to his disciples truly seals the whole work of the redemption of the world. Compare the human and the divine perspectives and you see the superiority of the divine. Makes us want to give up our petty human ways. He met them in a locked room and greeted them with Peace! Then he sent them into the world so that you and I may be saved, too! Amen.

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

The Risen Christ Breathes His Peace in the Holy Absolution

The crucified and risen Lord Jesus appeared to His apostles on the first Easter Sunday. He "came and stood among them," and with His Word and the wounds in "his hands and his side," He granted them His peace (John 20:19–20). He sent them as ministers of the Gospel in His name to bestow the life-giving Holy Spirit for us and for His whole Church through the forgiveness of sins (John 20:21–23). Through this apostolic ministry, He calls us to believe that He "is the Christ, the Son of God," so that by such faith we "may have life in his name" (John 20:31). The apostles "have seen and heard" this divine life manifested in the flesh of Christ, and those who succeed them in this apostolic ministry now proclaim that same Absolution to us, so that we "too may have fellowship" with the risen Christ, with the apostles and "with one another" (1 John 1:1–7). The one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church lives by "their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus," and all who believe this Word are "of one heart and soul," because in Him they truly have "everything in common" (Acts 4:32–33).
