# Fifth Sunday of Easter PRAYER AND PREACHING

## "CONFIRMATION INSTRUCTION IN A CHARIOT"

**Text**: Acts 8:30-31 "Do you understand what you are reading?" Phillip asked. "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me." So he invited Phillip to come up and sit with him [in the chariot].

**INTRODUCTION** – Today we learn that the Holy Spirit acts like the manager of the church. He appoints the right workers to the right areas to accomplish a specific task. Then he makes sure they have all the conditions to do their work. This story is repeated often nowadays in our world. Today's story, however, involves Phillip, the Gaza road, and the instruction of a very influential man from Ethiopia.

- 8 Catechumens today renew their baptismal vow.
- 9 Each has his/her own place in the world, assigned by God.
- 10 Each one teaches others as Phillip did.

**CONCLUSION** – Not everyone is born to be a teacher of the faith or a pastor. But each baptized and instructed Christian knows enough to bring someone to Christ. Invite them to church and put them in touch with a pastor or a teacher of the faith. That is even simpler than it sounds, because you will not be acting on your own: the Holy Spirit will manage you as he managed Phillip! Do it to the glory of God, from whom all blessings flow! Amen.

## Jesus Christ Is the True Vine Who Bears Much Fruit in Us

"God is love," and He has manifested Himself to us by sending "his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him" (1 John 4:9, 16). By the ministry of the Gospel, "he has given us of his Spirit," so that we also believe and confess "that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh." In this way, we "abide in him and he in us," and we "love one another" (1 John 4:2, 7, 13). Such divine love is exemplified in Philip's preaching of "the good news about Jesus" to the Ethiopian eunuch. And when "they came to some water," the eunuch was baptized into the very Gospel that Philip had preached (Acts 8:35–38). That Ethiopian was thereby grafted into "the true vine," Jesus Christ (John 15:1), just as we are. Already we are clean because of the Word that Christ has spoken to us and by the washing of water with His Word. We now abide in Him by faith in His forgiveness. As He abides in us, both body and soul, with His own body and His blood, He "bears much fruit" in us (John 15:3–5).
