**REMAIN IN THE FAITH**

Text: 2 Timothy 3:14 "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and become convinced of... and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures which are able to make you wise unto salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

INTRODUCTION – Today, perhaps more so than in the past, I am keenly aware that the pulpit belongs to Christ. For that reason, today, like in the past you will hear the Gospel, as best I can teach it. I hope you did not come to hear a great farewell sermon, Pastor Sander's last sermon, etc. We'll be around town, and we'll spend eternity together. Today I want to leave with you the same message Paul wrote from prison to young Timothy, his successor in the ministry.

**1 – The setting: a Roman prison.**

**2 – The occasion: Paul's second imprisonment – not like his first!**

**3 – Feelings and emotions aside, only faith counts.**

**4 – Salvation is through faith in Christ Jesus.**

**5 – Faith: the greatest stabilizer in the storms of life.**

**6 – Faith's warranty: guaranteed not to fail – it is a gift from God.**

**7 – Keeping a healthy faith through reading your Bible.**

CONCLUSION – Yes, my family and I will miss you. It has been and exceedingly fulfilling time in our lives. You have been wonderful in proclaiming the Gospel outside of this campus, reaching faraway lands and peoples. You allowed me to be a part in this great operation. I thank God for you. It's been a nice run! Now, remain in the faith. Don't make me come back! In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

### THIRD SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

#### *The Lord Is Manifested as Our Savior through the Preaching of the Gospel*

When Jesus opens His mouth to preach, gracious words flow from His lips. The Scriptures are, indeed, fulfilled in your hearing (Luke 4:21–22). For Christ was anointed by the Spirit of the Lord “to proclaim good news to the poor,” “to proclaim liberty to the captives” and “to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor” (Luke 4:18–19). By this proclamation, Christ releases His people from captivity and gathers them to Himself in His Church. So it was when the Lord released His people from Babylon and returned them to Jerusalem. “Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people,” sanctified the whole congregation by the reading and preaching of the Law (Neh. 8:8–9). As the people then were urged to “eat the fat and drink sweet wine and send portions to anyone who has nothing ready” (Neh. 8:10), so are you anointed by the Spirit of the Lord Jesus Christ to share in His feast and to serve the fellow members of His Body with His good gifts, “giving greater honor to the part that lacked it” (1 Cor. 12:12, 24)
